Research Scholarship

Chapter 143 of the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi invites applications from undergraduate students at YSU for the Chapter 143 Scholarship for Undergraduate Research. This scholarship recognizes students who have been actively involved in research, at YSU or through an off-campus research experience. The minimum value of the scholarship is \$200.

Students must meet the following eligibility criteria:

1. Students must have completed a minimum of sixty semester hours but no more than ninety semester hours of coursework at the time of application. Applicants do not need to be current members of Phi Kappa Phi.
2. Student must carry a minimum of a 3.7 GPA at the time of the nomination.
3. The application form shall include a list of research activities, the dates of research, and a list of any presentations or publications the student prepared as a result of the research.
4. If the student was involved in a multiple-authored effort, a statement must be submitted indicating the portion of the research the student was responsible for undertaking.
5. A 150-word description of a significant research activity must accompany the application.
6. A letter of support from a supervising faculty member or research supervisor should be attached to the application.
